Reference Material for the Annual Meeting of Shareholders

Proposal 1: Partial Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation

1. Reasons for the proposal

- (1) The Company intends to add purposes of the Company to the Article 2 (Purposes) of the current Articles of Incorporation to reflect the increased diversity our subsidiaries' businesses as well as the businesses of our newly established subsidiaries.
- (2) The Company intends to modify the Article 13 (Record Date for the Annual Meeting of Shareholders) and the Article 36 (Record Date of Dividends) of the current Articles of Incorporation to reflect the change in the fiscal year of the Company. Currently, the fiscal year of the Company begins on April 1 and ends on March 31 of the following year. The Company wishes to change its fiscal year beginning on January 1 of every year and ending on December 31 of the same year, to unify the fiscal year for the group companies. This unification of fiscal year will enable the Company to promote integrated group management and more efficient global operations including budgetary planning and business performance management. With this change, the 56th fiscal year will cover nine (9) months from April 1, 2019, to December 31, 2019. Thus supplementary provisions are also to be established as a transitional measure.
- (3) The Company intends to increase the number of directors in the Article 18 (Number of Directors) of the current Articles of Incorporation to allow an increase in said number for the purpose of strengthening business execution and corporate governance.

Kenji Kajiwara, Koichi Ishida, and Tetsuya Takahashi serve for Senshukai Co., Ltd. as President and Representative Director, Director and Executive Officer, and General Manager of the Corporate Headquarters, respectively. The Company has extensive transactional relationships with these companies based on a capital and business alliance agreement. Dears Brain, Inc. and Planetwork Co., Ltd. compete with the Company in some areas.
- 3. There is no financial interest between any other candidates and the Company.
- 4. Kenji Kajiwara, Koichi Ishida, Tetsuya Takahashi, Masato Takahashi, Sayuri Morikawa, and Omou Yamazaki are candidates for Outside Directors. The Company has registered Masato Takahashi as an Independent Officer with the Tokyo Stock Exchange, Inc., as provided for by the aforementioned exchange. If he is elected, the Company will once again register him as an Independent Officer. Sayuri Morikawa and Omou Yamazaki satisfy the requirements for an Independent Officer as provided for by the Tokyo Stock Exchange, and the Company plans to submit notification to the exchange concerning their appointments as Independent Officer if they are elected.
- 5. Special remarks regarding the candidates for Outside Directors are as follows.
 - 1) Reasons for Election as Outside Directors

Kenji Kajiwara and Koichi Ishida were each nominated pursuant to the capital and business alliance agreement. They also have extensive expertise in corporate strategy. If elected, they will apply their expertise to benefit the Company's management and help strengthen the its relationship with Dears Brain, Inc., Planetwork Co., Ltd., and Senshukai Co., Ltd.

Tetsuya Takahashi was nominated pursuant to the capital and business alliance agreement. Although Takahashi has never engaged in the Company's management except as an outside executive, he has been in view of his extensive experience in corporate planning at a listed company.

Masato Takahashi has extensive expertise in e-commerce. If re-elected, he will use such expertise to benefit the management of the Company.

Sayuri Morikawa has extensive expertise in the Company's media and marketing operations. If elected, she will apply such expertise to the Company's management from an impartial perspective. Omou Yamazaki has extensive expertise in accounting. If elected, he will apply such expertise to the

Company management from an impartial perspective.

2) Agreement for limitation of liability entered into with Outside Directors

In order to secure competent human resources as Outside Directors, the Company's current Articles of Incorporation states that the Company may enter into an agreement with Outside Directors to limit their liability for damages to the Company within a certain range. The Company has entered a liability limitation agreement with Mr. Masato Takahashi, and it will continue the agreement if he is elected. The Company will also enter into the liability limitation agreements with Sayuri Morikawa and Omou Yamazaki if they are elected.

[The outline of the agreement is as follows.]

If Outside Directors become liable to the Company for any damage attributable to their failure of duties, their liability shall be limited to the minimum amount set forth in Article 425, Paragraph 1 of the Companies Act.

- 3) Mr. Masato Takahashi is Outside Director. At the close of this Annual Meeting of Shareholders, he will have served as Outside Directors for one (1) year.
- 6. The number of the Company's shares held by candidates includes shares held under the officers' share ownership plan.
- 7. Sayuri Morikawa's name on the family register is Sayuri (given name) Fujiyama (surname).
